NEW HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY TEST



Trumbull County will soon adopt a new exam approved by the

state of Ohio that will be an option for high school equivalency. The HiSET exam will be a slightly less expensive test with differences that may be helpful for some students' test taking skills and strengths. Just as the GED, vouchers to defer some cost will be available. Teachers at Aspire will be able to help students determine if this test would be beneficial and prepare for the differences.

Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (OOD) is the State of Ohio agency that partners with Ohioans with disabilities to achieve quality employment and independence. OOD works with partners in business, education and non-profit organizations to create employment plans for Ohioans with disabilities; help Ohio companies recruit and retain employees with disabilities; and is the sole agency administering the Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) programs in Ohio.
